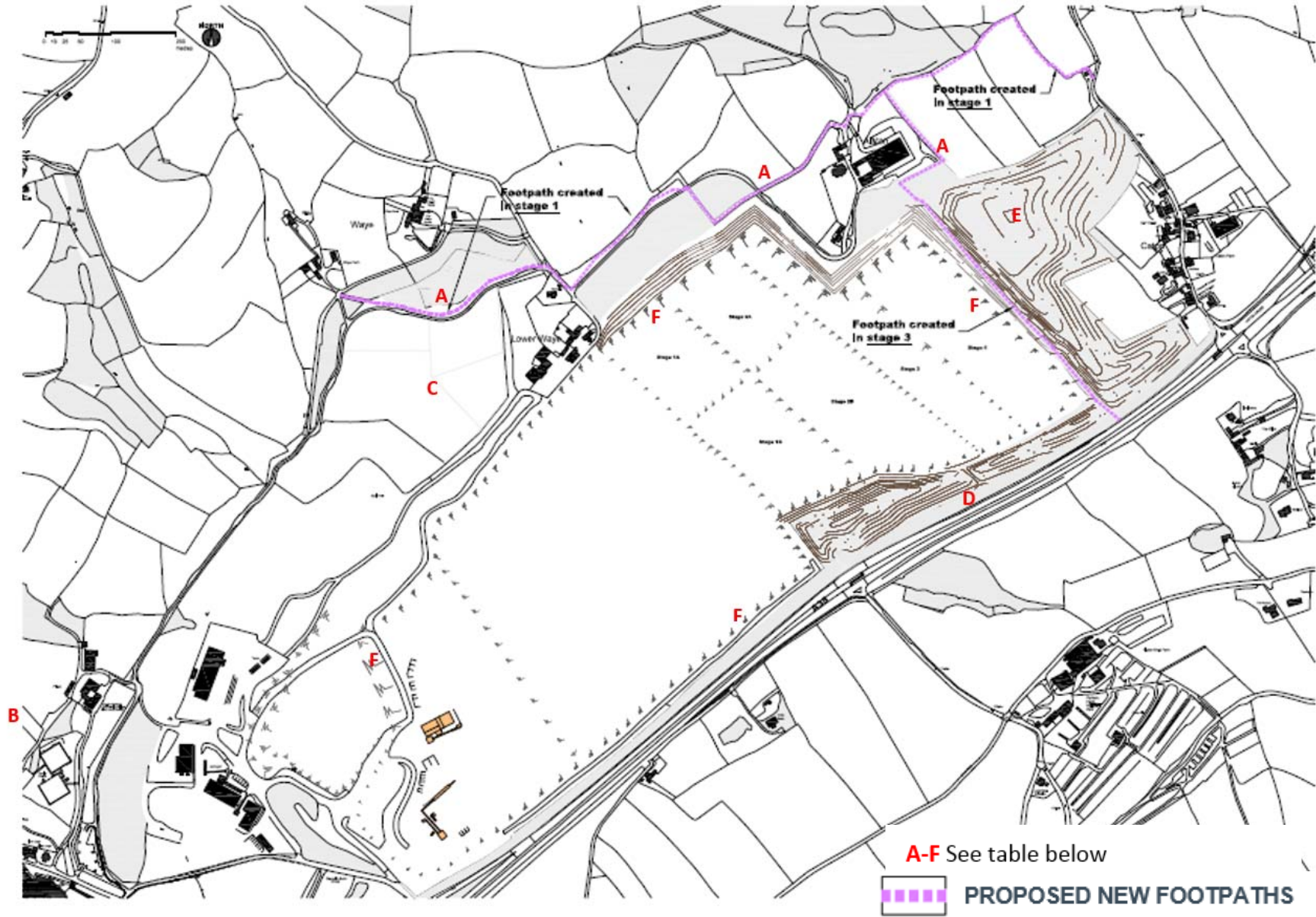

Public Access Intentions

Linhay Hill Quarry – Description of Public Access intentions – June 2016



Reference	Description
A	<p>Creation of the following footpaths:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • alongside northern part of Waye Lane in Stage 1 • path linking Alston Lane to Caton Lane in Stage 1, • From this path, via 'Green Lane' to A38 in stage 3.
B	<p>Access to an existing walled garden for community use via current private lane running north from Place Lane and around the northern perimeter of Place House from Waye Lane and diverted Ashburton footpath 16 in stage 1 (following clearance of Japanese Knotweed).</p>
C	<p>Provision of a quarry viewing platform and information board on the existing tip and link from parking area to be provided off the new Waye Lane</p>
D	<p>Footpath loop/s linking with the footpath along the A38. Timing to be agreed, will depend on outcome of a detailed specific risk assessment as set out in The Quarry Regulations 1999¹; may involve separate loops being introduced progressively.</p>
E	<p>Access to the new permanent bunds to be created at the eastern end of the extension following completion of planting on the completed bunds for informal sitting/picnic area. anticipated during Stage 2, year 16+, subject to agreement of access point from Caton Lane,</p>
F	<p>Circular recreational path proposed around the lake in restored quarry in stage 6. This can be linked to the 'Green Lane' footpath in A above if desired.</p>
